Supervisor report: Unfortunately the County has canceled all youth programs for the 2020 season, Web site should be finished and up and running by Wednesday, we need to advertise for Code Enforcement Officer, June 2 SLIC Communications will install Wi-Fi at Courtney Park and Minerva Lake. No password, it's open. We may, need this year, to hire an additional lifeguard the reason is we need somebody just to walk the property and enforce social distancing.

McCall: we may need additional because we normally use youth program and toward the end of the season they fill in quite often.

Steve: we will have the extra funds from the youth program, so we may need that extra, they'll be like a park attendant, 10 feet between blankets, half the parking spots, and monitoring the bathhouse too. Had meeting with Robbie, Keith and Dave, they're scheduling their shifts so we can do cleaning campsite four times a day, 7-11-4-8, since Keith is there between 4-8 he is taking over the night watchman job, the food pantry is just busy, this week we served 50 some families the people working the pantry are doing a great job.

Highway Superintendent: All started back to work last Friday, replaced a couple culverts on North Woods Club Road, got permit from DEC allowing replacement of almost every culver on NWC Road which will be financed indirectly from FEMA, as long as Essex County Soil and Water doesn't have a problem with it we're good and going all plastic. The sand bill over \$9000 have about 2/3 of what we need, took in 500 tons of salt to mix in with it and that still didn't complete our budget, 100 tons under from the start of the fiscal year. We got guys doing shared services in Schroon Lake paving
