Moxham Mountain is in The Vanderwacker Wilderness and is accessible from 14th Road in Minerva. It features a moderate trail with a few challenging uphill climbs and many views of surrounding mountains and Gore mountain. It's a great hike for the more athletic hiker. It can also be a shorter hike with young children who want to pack a lunch and sit on one of the many look-outs to enjoy the views. Blue berries and many varieties of mushrooms as well as some amazing rock formations are found along the trail. The name of the mountain stems from the surveyor, Robert Moxham who died from a fall from one of the mountain cliffs in 1799. The Essex County and Warren County borders cross just below the peak of Moxham.
