



Minerva Youth Commission Ski Program



It's that time! Registration forms are now available for kids in grade 3-12 who are interested in participating in the Minerva Youth Commission Saturday ski program.

The dates for 2024 are January 6, January 20, January 27, February 3, February 10 and February 24. The fee to participate is \$100 per child, \$75 if you have a season pass. If a student would like to participate but is financially unable, please contact Katy Smith @ 518-251-2000 as soon as possible. Scholarship funding may be available but is not guaranteed and must be requested no later than November 20th.

Students new to the ski program must be accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult coordinated by parents for the first 3 weeks of program. In addition, if your child does not advance with the rest of his or her group, you must continue to provide an individual ski/snowboard chaperone.

Transportation is provided. The bus will leave MCS at 7:30am and return between 3:40 & 3:45.

It is important that kids come prepared for program. They should bring a lunch & snacks, warm clothing, helmet, hat, mittens/gloves & scarf. A spare pair of dry gloves/mittens is highly recommended. **Please contact Katy Smith to have your child/children fitted for equipment at the school.**

Fill out and return application to **Katy Smith at MCS with payment**. Please be sure it is completely filled out and signed on the back by parent/guardian. Checks should be made payable to the Town of Minerva. Applications are due back by **Wednesday, November 29, 2023**. * Your child will not be enrolled in the program without full payment. *

Parents are welcome to chaperone. Chaperones are **expected** to assist with supervision of **ALL** kids throughout the day with the exception of lesson time (8:15-9:30). You will be assigned children besides your own to monitor, approximately (3-5) children depending on needs. In order to chaperone you must Prepay and Call Stacie McNally by Wednesday afternoon to chaperone that Saturday. These tickets are on a first come basis and are nonrefundable.
