## RECYCLING GUIDE

ITEMS TO BE RECYCLED	PREPARATION	RESTRICTIONS
<b>Glass</b>	Empty and clean Remove lids and caps	NO ceramics, dishes, drinking glasses, light bulbs, window glass, mirrors, crystal, Pyrex or laboratory glass
<b>Plastic</b> 	Empty and clean Remove lids and caps	NO #2 motor oil bottles, pesticide containers or plastic bags
<b>Tin and Aluminum cans</b>	Empty and clean	NO propane cylinders
<b>Newspaper</b>	Clean and dry All inserts okay Loose papers only – NO string or plastic bags	Newspaper only No Magazines or catalogs Recycle other paper items separately
<b>Magazines and Catalogs</b>	Clean and dry	
<b>Corrugated Cardboard</b> Cardboard with ridged center Brown paper grocery bags	Clean and dry. Broken down or flattened. <u>NOT</u> crushed.	NO pizza boxes
<b>Office Papers and Junk Mail</b> <b>Box Board</b> <b>Phone Books and Paperback Books</b>	Clean and dry Clean and dry	NO waxed, plastic or foil coated boxes NO pizza boxes NO milk cartons or juice boxes

ITEMS TO BE RECYCLED	PREPARATION	RESTRICTIONS
<b>Ferrous/Non-ferrous Scrap Metals and White Goods</b> (Large Appliances).	Remove doors from refrigerators and freezers Remove firebrick from stoves and furnaces	NO batteries NO closed (unopened) containers such as fuel tanks, propane tanks, aerosol cans or metal drums NO liquid paint, oil or fuel
<b>TV &amp; Computer Monitors</b>	Fees apply, see transfer station attendant for fee schedule	
<b>Tires</b>	With or without rims. Fees apply, see transfer station attendant for fee schedule	
<b>Yard Waste</b>	We have a brush pile available for small brush, leaves and clipping.	NO bags or boxes, if using to transport they must be emptied and disposed of separately

# TOWN OF MINERVA DISPOSAL GUIDE

<b>Household Garbage</b>	Keep separate from recyclables, scrap metal and construction and demolition debris Place in clear or transparent bags	NO liquid paint or stain (remove lid to dry contents prior to disposal) NO flammable liquids NO dead animals NO loose hypodermic needles or razors (place in non-recyclable, clear plastic container prior to disposal with household garbage)
<b>Furniture Carpeting/Linoleum, mattresses and other bulky items</b>	Separate metal components and place in scrap metal container if possible.	NO oversized items Large items may require some dismantling Check with the transfer station attendant prior to drop off
<b>Construction and Demolition Debris Masonry materials, lumber, plaster/drywall, porcelain, plumbing fixtures, insulation, siding, roofing, electrical wiring</b>	Remove all appliances, carpets, furniture, beds, tires, curtains, clothing, and household garbage  Remove scrap metal Fees Apply, see transfer station attendant for fee schedule	NO recyclables NO household garbage NO drums, paint cans or plastic buckets NO friable asbestos NO stumps or brush NO fluorescent light ballasts or transformers NO regulated waste

## THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED:

***Industrial waste, hazardous waste, regulated medical waste, radioactive waste, junk motor vehicles, dead animals, petroleum waste, liquid wastes, pressurized tanks and all out of town waste.***

## FEE SCHEDULE

Trash	Free to residents <u>all</u> year Free to campers with a valid Minerva Campground permit \$2.00 per bag non-residents; visit the Town Hall to purchase a per bag card.
Air Conditioner, Refrigerator, or Freezer- Freon based appliance.	1 Free to residents per year; \$15 for each additional
TV and Computer Monitors	1 Free to residents per year; Up to 12" - \$5.00, as measured diagonally. 13" to 18" - \$10.00, as measured diagonally. 18" and up - \$15.00, as measured diagonally.
Tires	4 car or light truck tires (up to 24") per household; \$3 per tire thereafter up to 24", \$10 for big truck/equipment tires 24" and larger.
Recyclables	Free
Bulky Waste	Free to Residents
C&D	\$50 full yard, \$25 half yard, \$12.50 quarter yard.
